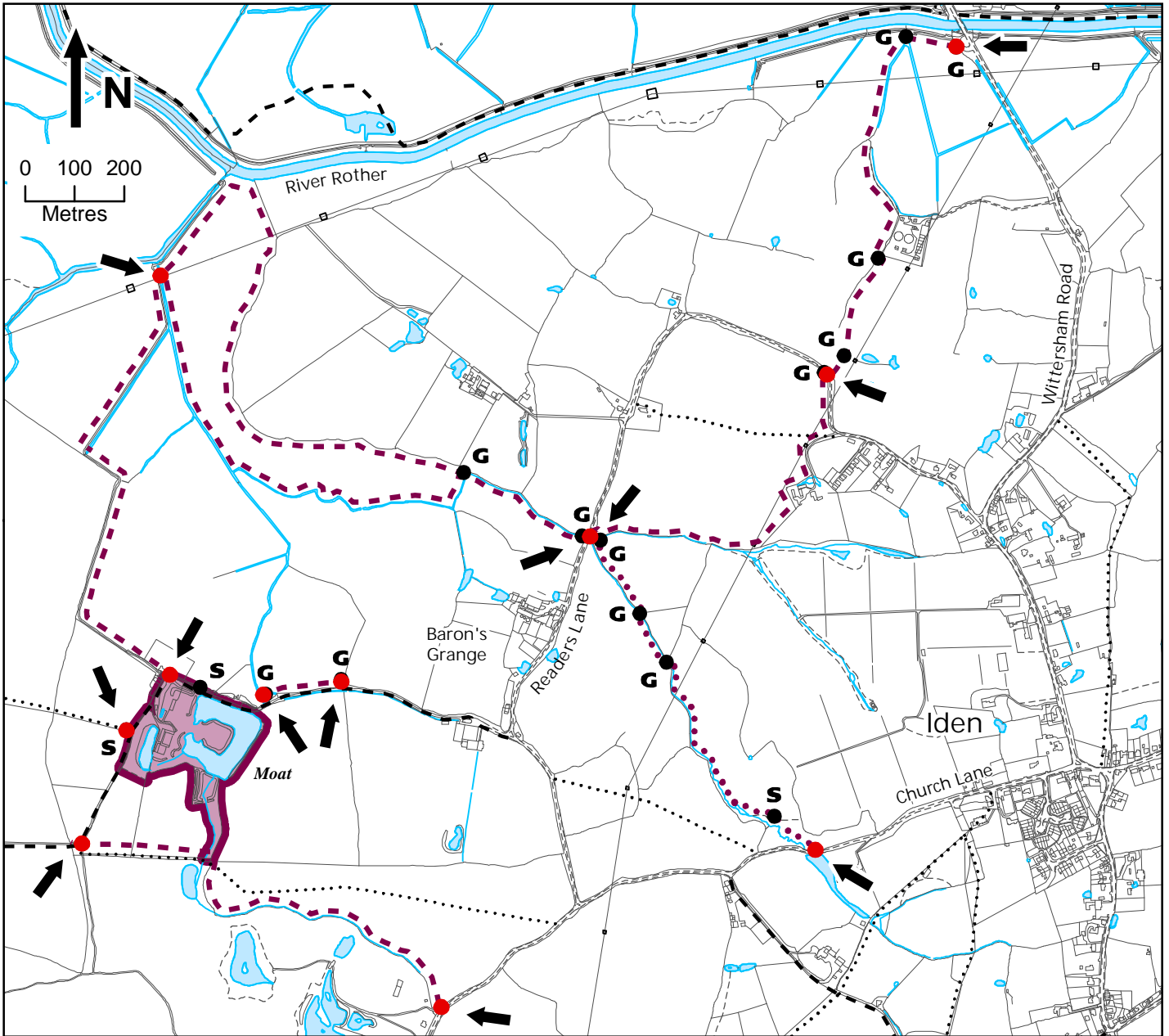


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

The path and bridleway lead to the Rother Plain and afford fine views across Walland and Romney Marsh. The land here was once sea, and like at Rye, ships once landed here. The bridleway provides a safe route avoiding the main road between Iden and the New Bridge.

The circular walk links with public footpaths and allows access to the river Rother and a Moat. The latter is an important historic site, and is rich in wildlife.
