The excellent microclimate, sandy soils and long, slow ripening season result in consistent award winning wines. Oxford Dry – our bestseller, a light, dry white wine, with grapefruit and tropical fruit flavours such as kiwi and pineapple. Renaissance – tastes of nectarines and a hint of dill seed on the nose giving way to peaches and cream on the palate. Just off dry, this blend of Optima and Ortega has a wonderful balance – won award for best regional white wine in 2004.

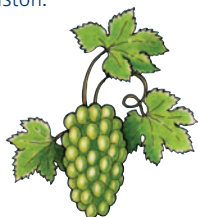

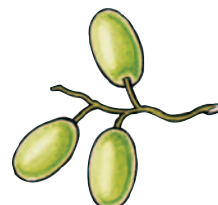
